Basic Breastfeeding Course (2024/2025)

The Nursing Council of Hong Kong has approved the Hospital Authority as a provider of Continuing Nursing Education (CNE) since 2005.

AIMS OF THE COURSE

- To develop nurses' knowledge, skill and competence, in using effective counselling skill to build up mother's confidence, and giving consistent messages to protect, promote and support breastfeeding in the facilities where they work.
- To enhance nurses' understanding of the importance of the Ten Steps to Successful Breastfeeding and collaboration to support the "Baby-Friendly Hospital Initiative" in HA hospitals.

INTENDED LEARNING OUTCOMES

On completion of the course, participants should be able to:

- acquire the update knowledge in basic breastfeeding and steps to support successful breastfeeding,
- assess breastfeeding mothers and their newborn babies,
- provide assistance to help a mother and her baby with breastfeeding,
- identify and manage common breastfeeding difficulties, and
- to talk with mothers with counselling skills in the antenatal, postnatal and neonatal periods, and support them in their infant feeding decisions.
