

HKICC Crash Program

The Nursing Council of Hong Kong has approved the Hospital Authority as a provider of Continuing Nursing Education (CNE) since 2005

Program Information

Aim

This 3-day program is designed to equip nurses and PCAs with necessary knowledge and skill in managing COVID-19 patients, as well as prepare a pool of trained nurses and PCAs to care for COVID-19 patients requiring monitoring and ready for urgent deployment to Hong Kong Infection Control Center (HKICC), Asia World Expo Community Treatment Facility (AWECTF) and Penny Bay Isolation Centre (PBIC) in response to COVID-19 pandemic.

Intended Learning Outcomes

Upon completion of the program, participants should be able to:

- familiar with the clinical setting and workflow of HKICC, AWECTF and PBIC
- demonstrate competencies in admitting COVID-19 patient, monitoring and managing their disease progress as well as discharging the patients in according to prevailing isolation ordinance
- demonstrate competencies in operating various IT and NI system as well as the equipment used in HKICC
- apply the learned skill and knowledge in managing COVID-19 patients requiring resuscitation and interhospital transfer

3-day training on weekly basis with 1-day lecture, scenario-based training, demo and hands-on practice and 2-day on-the-job coaching with clinical duties
