### Preparation for the e-Quiz:

1. Register your HA internet email address (emails end with [@ha.org.hk](mailto:@ha.org.hk) are internet, otherwise are intranet) ([Click here](#) for internet email application.)
2. The e-Quiz will be delivered by Google Form, please ensure you have adequate device(s) to show your face in Zoom AND perform the e-Quiz at the same time. Those device(s) should be connecting to the Internet.
3. Join the mock exam session for a trial of e-Quiz, and settle all technical issues if any

### On the Examination Day:

1. Join the Zoom meeting at least 15 mins before the examination starts
2. Mark your name as instructed for registration (eg. using your participant no., full name, hospital and title when joining the e-Quiz)
3. Turn on video mode to show your face throughout the examination (no virtual background is allowed)
4. Open the e-Quiz URL / scan the QR Code as provided by the invigilator
5. Input your HA internet email address on Google form as your identification
6. Read the instructions for the examination as shown in the Google form
7. The password of the e-Quiz will be announced by the invigilator via Zoom and also provided via 'chat function' in Zoom
8. Start working on the e-Quiz once you have unlocked the examination paper with the provided password
9. Answer all questions in the examination paper
10. Submit the e-Quiz before the allowed time of the examination. (Only first submission will be marked, NO late submission)
