This course is the Fundamental Module of the Post-registration Certificate Course in Advanced Medical Nursing (15/3/2022 – 15/11/2022). Nurses who have been nominated to the full course of PRCC in Advanced Medical Nursing are not required to enroll in this module.

AIMS

To develop the competence of nurses for advanced practice in medical nursing so as to promote a high standard of care for patients in general medical settings

PROGRAM INTENDED LEARNING OUTCOMES (PILOS)

Upon completion of this program, course participants will be able to:

- 1. Demonstrate effective health assessment skills to identify the health care needs of individuals
- 2. Integrate knowledge on pathophysiology and management of common adult health conditions in the planning of care for adult patients in general medical settings
- 3. Implement holistic care for adult patients based on the identified physical and psychosocial needs
- 4. Evaluate the outcome of care provided and modify interventions as necessary
- 5. Provide client-centred patient and family education to facilitate the treatment process and promote health maintenance

Preparation for the e-Quiz:

- 1. Register your HA internet email address (emails end with @ha.org.hk are internet, otherwise are intranet) (Click here for internet email application.)
- 2. The e-Quiz will be delivered by Google Form, please ensure you have adequate device(s) to show your face in Zoom <u>AND</u> perform the e-Quiz at the same time. Those device(s) should be connecting to the Internet.
- 3. Join the mock exam session for a trial of e-Quiz, and settle all technical issues if any

Suggested device(s) combination:

On the Examination Day:

- 7. The password of the e-Quiz will be announced by the invigilator via Zoom and also provided via 'chat function' in Zoom
