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PROGRAM INFORMATION

1.1 PROGRAM AIM(s)

1. To equip nurses with the knowledge and skills to provide quality care for adult respiratory patients.

1.2 PROGRAM INTENDED LEARNING OUTCOMES

Upon completion of the program, the participants should be able to:

1. Describe the pathophysiology, clinical manifestations, and treatment modalities of diseases / illnesses and conditions in respiratory care.
2. Analyze investigation and health assessment result of patients with respiratory diseases for making nursing judgments.
3. Formulate individualized and holistic care plan for patients with respiratory diseases and their family / carer / significant others.
4. Assist and perform respiratory procedures/ interventional therapies and related care management.
5. Integrate evidence-based practice and specialty specific knowledge in devising holistic care for patients with respiratory disease.
6. Evaluate patients' response to planned care with revision of care plan based on evidence-based knowledge and data interpretation.
7. Organize care management in multidisciplinary approach and across different clinical services and settings e.g. acute, rehabilitation, ambulatory and community services.

1.3 TARGET PARTICIPANTS

1. Nurses in RN rank.
2. Priority will be given to those who are currently working in Respiratory unit in HA hospitals / institutions.
3. Nurses who have previously enrolled in PRCC without successful completion may be given low priority.
4. Participant who successfully completed the Fundamental Course in Respiratory Nursing in the classes of 11 Jan – 25 Jan 2022 or 20 Apr – 04 May 2023 will be eligible to apply for direct entry to Module II.

1.4 ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

1. Registered nurses with valid practicing certificate issued by the Nursing Council of Hong Kong.
2. Nurses having not less than 24 months post-registration experience.

9. GUIDELINES FOR GROUP PROJECT/PATIENT CARE STUDY

A. Group Project

The participants will be divided into groups of 6-9 participants to work on a project. The design of the project should aim to bring about improvement in patient care or clinical services, with an emphasis on integration of knowledge and practice in delivering respiratory nursing service.

Suggested Format for Group Project

1. Cover page with the project title, name of program participants and their parent hospitals
2. Table of contents
3. Introduction of the project
4. Rationale and significance
5. The implementation (or implementation plan)
6. Discussion / Evaluation
7. Conclusion / Recommendation
8. References

- Word limit: 2,500 words +/- 10%
- The desirable oral presentation time is 20 minutes

Points to notes for group project presentation

1. The participants are encouraged to use audio-visual aids during presentation.
2. The participants are required to seek advice from their respective supervisor/ visiting lecturers/ co-program director / program director on the project works.
3. The participants should submit their assignment according to the deadline of each assignment. Any submission after the deadline will be deemed as the 2nd attempt and the maximum score will be 50% of the full score of the respective assessment. Any late submission beyond 4 weeks of the pre-set deadline will not be marked and no further attempt will be offered.

B. Patient Care Study

The participants are required to select a patient in the respiratory care unit whom he/she has nursed **at least two spans of duty** during the clinical practicum period and write a patient care study. It is expected that participants will apply their knowledge in respiratory nursing to formulate a care plan using a problem-solving approach.

The Patient Care Study should be typewritten and submitted **on or before the end of Week 6 of their clinical practicum**. The word limit is 2,000 words +/- 10%.

Points to notes for case study

1. The participants are required to discuss with Nursing Specialty Mentors on patient care study during clinical practicum.
2. The participants should submit their assignment according to the deadline. Any submission after the deadline will be deemed as the 2nd attempt and the maximum score will be 50% of the full score of the respective assessment. Any late submission beyond 4 weeks of the pre-set deadline will not be marked and no further attempt will be offered.
