- 3. Nurses who have previously enrolled in PRCC without successful completion may be given low priority
- 4. Participant who successfully completed the Fundamental Course in Gastroenterology and Endoscopy Nursing in 3 years will be eligible to apply for direct entry to Module II.

- 1. Registered nurses with valid practicing certificate issued by the Nursing Council of Hong Kong.
- 2. Nurses having not less than 24 months post-registration experience.
