COURSE AIM(S)

To introduce foundation concepts in ENT nursing and enhance nurses' competency in the care of patients with otology, rhinology, laryngology and head & neck surgical problems

1. Explain pathophysiology and management of common ENT diseases and head & neck surgical problems
2. Describe the nursing responsibilities for ENT endoscopic examinations
3. Identify common symptoms experienced by patients with otology, rhinology, laryngology and head & neck surgical problems
4. Acquire nursing skills in management of patients with ENT, head & neck surgical problems
