## COURSE AIM(S)

To introduce foundation concepts in ENT nursing and enhance nurses' competency in the care of patients with otology, rhinology, laryngology and head & neck surgical problems

## **COURSE INTENDED LEARNING OUTCOMES**

Upon completion of the course, the participants should be able to:

- 1. Explain pathophysiology and management of common ENT diseases and head & neck surgical problems
- 2. Describe the nursing responsibilities for ENT endoscopic examinations
- 3. Identify common symptoms experienced by patients with otology, rhinology, laryngology and head & neck surgical problems
- 4. Acquire nursing skills in management of patients with ENT, head & neck surgical problems

- Priority will be given to those who are currently working in ENT or related departments in HA hospitals / institutions.
