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### Keynote overseas speakers:

### Ms. Olivia Martin

Ms. Olivia Martin is the current Service Coordinator of RPA Virtual Hospital in Sydney Local Health District, where she coordinates the development, implementation and evaluation of a new virtual rehabilitation model of care. Prior to her current position, she also served as the Head of Speech Pathology Department in Canterbury Hospital from 2017 to 2021, as well as the Allied Health Service Coordinator in RPA Virtual Hospital starting from September 2023. She has extensive experience across all health care settings, using both in-person and virtual modalities.

#### Ms. Jaimie Karamihas

Ms. Jaimie Karamihas is the physiotherapist working in the RPA Virtual Hospital in Sydney Local Health District. She is experienced in providing virtual rehabilitation, facilitating an early supported discharge for patients from acute and sub-acute wards, using verbal and non-verbal communication skills to facilitate understanding and provide effective patient care virtually as well as conducting effective assessment and treatment to patients virtually.

#### Dr. Michelle Cottrell

Dr. Michelle Cottrell is an early-career allied-health clinician researcher. She currently holds both a Research Coordinator and Telehealth Coordinator with the Royal Brisbane and Women's Hospital Physiotherapy Department, while currently seconded as the Allied Health Research Coordinator at the Prince Charles Hospital. She also holds an Associate Lecturer position at the University of Queensland. She has ample experience in clinical researches on implementation of telehealth within Allied Health services, with over 30 publications and 1,500 citations.

## Dr. Peter Window

Dr. Peter Window is the Senior Physiotherapist in Royal Brisbane and Women's Hospital (RBWH), who specializes in musculoskeletal rehabilitation. He also serves as the Research Coordinator in Physiotherapy Department of RBWH. He has established a program of research under two focuses: use of technology in rehabilitation and utilizing implementation science methodology to translate research into practice in health service settings. The program has produced over 15 publications and has been referenced by Moving Medicine, a UK online resource to encourage exercise with endorsement from Professional bodies such as the Royal College of Physicians.
