Aim: To strengthen clinical psychologists' ability to support advance decisions on life-sustaining treatment and address psychological needs in end-of-life care.

Objective/ Intended Learning Outcome:

By the end of the workshop, participants will be able to:

- Outline the key provisions of the Advance Decision on Life-Sustaining Treatment Ordinance relevant to clinical psychology.
- 2. Address ethical and emotional factors in advance care planning and end-of-life decisions.
- 3. Apply psychological approaches to support patients and families in decision-making and symptom management.
- 4. Collaborate with multidisciplinary teams to meet psychosocial needs in end-of-life settings.

Target Participant:1. Candidates of Advanced Specialty Program (ASP) in Psychological

2. HA clinical psychologists who are not ASP candidates (non-ASP CPs), with at least 7 years of experience, and who are either

a. currently working in a medical setting, or

b. expected to be involved in a medical setting within the coming

year

Priority will be given to the above target participants. Other HA clinical

psychologists may enroll if vacancies remain.

- 1. For ASP candidates, please refer to the ASP program book for specific requirements.

 - b. **Pass the Mini-Assessment** (consisting of 5 multiple-choice questions, one attempt only, passing rate: 70%) conducted via eLC+ immediately after class.
