COURSE INFORMATION

This course is the Fundamental Module of the Post-registration Certificate Course in Anaesthetic and Recovery Nursing (18/04/2026-23/10/2026). Nurses who have been nominated to the PRCC in Anaesthetic and Recovery Nursing are not required to enroll in this course.

COURSE AIM(S)

This course focuses on the basic concepts on anaesthetic and recovery nursing so as to enhance the nursing knowledge and skills in managing patients in the peri-anaesthetic setting.

COURSE INTENDED LEARNING OUTCOMES

Upon completion of the course, the participants should be able to:

1. Identify the concepts of peri-anaesthetic nursing
2. Understand the principles of general and regional anaesthesia, airway management and clinical monitoring in peri-anaesthetic setting
3. Acquire the basic knowledge and skills and pain management in the Post-anaesthesia Care Unit (PACU)
4. Identify the nursing role in the PACU
5. Recognize the preparation and use of intubation equipment and consumable

TARGET PARTICIPANTS

1. Nurses in EN, RN or above ranks
2. Priority will be given to those who are currently working in peri-operative settings in HA hospitals / institutions.
