- 9. Appraise nursing roles in urology nursing and prepare for taking up advanced nursing practice, leadership, research & resource person roles in clinical setting
- 10. Critique methods for evaluating healthcare interventions and outcomes
- 11. Demonstrate ability to conduct innovative clinical projects and adopt appropriate research methodology to facilitate continuous quality improvement in the urology specialty
