AIM

1. To develop the competence of registered nurses in urology nursing in order to ensure a high standard of specialized care for urology clients

3. To develop nurses' awareness of relevant evidence-based findings and facilitate integration of these findings into urology nursing practice

5. Integrates knowledge of urological issues with nursing principles to provide perioperative management
6. Apply evidence-based knowledge to construct and evaluate holistic nursing care for patients requiring urological care
7. Organize nursing management in terms of multidisciplinary approach and perform specialized skills in the provision of quality care for urology patients
8. Critically evaluate on-going therapeutic interventions and clinical outcomes of the care and treatment for patients requiring urological care
9. Appraise nursing roles in urology nursing and prepare for taking up advanced nursing practice, leadership, research & resource person roles in clinical setting
10. Critique methods for evaluating healthcare interventions and outcomes
11. Demonstrate ability to conduct innovative clinical projects and adopt appropriate research methodology to facilitate continuous quality improvement in the urology specialty
12. Integrates psycho-social care to clients and their significant others requiring urological care
